- Floating Accommodator:** Any accommodator from the Bylaw Area (geographical area defined by Columbia Shuswap Regional District Bylaw No. 5433, imposing an additional accommodation tax under the provisions of the *Hotel room Tax Act*) who collects the 2% AHRT.
- Independent Accommodator:** Hotels or motels operating within the boundaries of the Town of Golden that are not franchised or a part of a chain.
- Tourism Operator Director:** Any tourism activity operator operating within the Bylaw area as defined above.

**The following rules apply under article III Section 3 of Tourism Golden Bylaws:**

- a) Only persons representing Accommodators that collect the Additional Hotel Room Tax or Tourism Operators conducting business within the Bylaw Area may be an elected director. And,
- b) Only persons representing a Partner (Stakeholder that has participated in at least one Association program not more than fourteen months prior to, and not less than 60 days prior to the General Meeting) operating within the boundaries of the Bylaw Area may be an elected director. And,
- c) Only persons representing members in good standing may be an elected director.

**Definitions:**

- **Voting member** is defined as either an Accommodator registered with Tourism Golden or a Stakeholder who operates within the Bylaw area and has participated in at least one (1) Tourism Golden program not more than fourteen (14) months prior to, and not less than 60 days prior to the Annual General Meeting.
- **Accommodator** is defined as any establishment offering overnight accommodation that levies the Additional Hotel Room Tax.
- **Stakeholder** means any person, business, private or public organization, governmental authority or unincorporated group registered with the Association as a Stakeholder.
